



## Covid-19 Pandemic-Specific Information with Particular Regard to Spectators

### SPECTATORS

***Please note this section will only be applicable when Aberdeenshire Council local authority is within the Tier 1 coronavirus structure which allows football matches with spectators.***

For the purposes of clarity of application, a spectator is defined as a person who attends a match in a non-official capacity, i.e., those who are neither match critical nor listed on the Club's Official Return. Those defined as match critical are players, technical staff, match officials, first aid staff and the Club Official with Red & Amber Zone clearance. Others who are listed on the Club's Official Return must be accommodated within the Green Zone. It is recommended that Home Club Officials in the Green Zone are clearly identified & take an active role in supporting Covid-19 regulatory compliance.

<b>Home Club Protocols</b>
This protocol will be made available to spectators via the club website ( <a href="http://www.huntlyfc.co.uk">www.huntlyfc.co.uk</a> ), the Club social media and emailed to the Away Team to pass onto their supporters club.
<b>Attendees</b>
It should be stated that any attendees (with the exception of Club Staff & Officials) should be from the local area as defined by the Scottish Government from time to time.
<b>Accommodation</b>
Spectators will be accommodated within the Green Zone.
<b>Stand Seating</b>
No stand seating is available.
<b>Ticketing</b>
The club will utilise an admission system with numbered tickets being issued. Contact details for the purchaser will be gathered at the point of sale.
<b>Green Zone Register</b>
A register to be maintained of all those who have attended match, this will act as Track and Trace.
<b>Social Distancing &amp; Face Coverings</b>
The Scottish Government recommended 2 meter social distancing and wearing of face coverings is mandatory for all persons at all times within the stadium, this also includes wearing the mask on entry to the ground. Huntly FC will not provide face coverings for attendees.
<b>Travel</b>
Car parking is available in the large car park in East Park Street and surrounding streets. Parking cannot be guaranteed.
<b>Arrival at Stadium</b>

Spectators should arrive at the Stadium no earlier than 30 (Thirty) minutes prior to Kick Off and enter via two gates at the turnstile block (non-turnstile entry). Attendees must form a socially distanced queue and not enter the ground until a temperature check has been completed.

Temperature checking and attendance register check will be undertaken at the entrance gate. If temperature is found to be in excess of 37.8°C the attendee will be asked to move to a safe area then re-tested after 10 minutes. If temperature is still over 37.8°C access to stadium to be denied and they will be asked to leave.

Face masks must be worn and hand sanitiser is to be used on entry.

Spectators will stand within the green zone area as detailed in the stadium plan. Clear signage will be outside and within the stadium.

Toilet facilities to be used are the toilets within the toilet block beside the turnstiles.

### **Spectator Circulation**

Spectators will social distance themselves within the green zone area of the stadium.

### **Tea Bar and Other Concessions**

These to be remain closed under current guidelines

### **Exiting Stadium**

Spectators to exit the ground socially distanced, orderly and as soon as possible after the final whistle. Exit points will be the two large exit gates either side of the toilet block at the East Park Street end of the ground.
